- (j) Co-operation in Tourism and Wildlife;
- (k) Co-operation in Health, Social and Cultural Activities and Gender Development;
- (l) Co-operation in Political Matters;
- (m) Co-operation in Legal and Judicial Affairs; and
- (n) Co-operation in the involvement and development of the Private Sector and Civil Society

## Article 9 Financial Obligations

The Republic of Burundi shall upon accession be subject to the financial and budgetary obligations and requirements of the Treaty on the Partner States.

## Article 10 Ratification and Depository

This Treaty shall be ratified by the Republic of Burundi in accordance with her constitutional requirements. The Republic of Burundi shall deposit her instruments of ratification with the Secretary General of the East African Community.

## Article 11 Entry into Force

This Treaty shall enter into force on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2007 provided that all the instruments of ratification have been deposited before that date.

## Article 12 Registration

This Treaty shall be registered with the African Union, the United Nations and such other organizations as the East African Community Council of Ministers may determine.
