# Appendix II

# COMPETENT AUTHORITIES

# A. Competent authorities of the European Community

Control is shared between the national services of the Member States and the European Commission. In this respect the following applies:

- As regards exports to Ghana, the EC Member States are responsible for control of the production circumstances and requirements, including statutory inspections and issuing health (or animal welfare) certifications attesting to the agreed standards and requirements;
- As regards imports from Ghana, the Member States are responsible for control of the compliance of the imports with the Community's import conditions;
- The European Commission is responsible for overall coordination, inspection/audits of inspection systems and the
  necessary legislative action to ensure uniform application of standards and requirements within the internal EC
  market.

# B. Competent authorities of Ghana

These authorities will be designated by Ghana and notified to the EPA Committee not later than three months from the date of signature of the present Agreement. The EPA Committee will adopt an amended appendix.
