	Conditions creating the need for the exemption
	This exemption is necessary as the establishment of foreign law firms in Brunei Darussalam is based on case-by-case approval.
	To promote social, economic and cultural relations.
	To accord differentiated treatment to another country which accords favourable treatment to Brunei Darussalam financial institutions.

	To promote greater cooperation amongst ASEAN in the reinsurance sector.
	The currency interchangeability agreement was entered into force in 1967 arising from special historical and economic ties between Brunei Darussalam and Singapore.
